Facilities

- 5 star grading by Botswana Tourism Organisation.
- Green Plus EcoTourism Certificate.
- Maximum 16 guests.
- Dining room, bar, sitting area and campfire overlooking a permanent water hole.
- Star deck for dining under the night sky.
- Seven spacious twin/double bedded tents with en-suite bathrooms (triple on request).
- One family tent (sleeping five people in two bedrooms with shared en-suite bathroom).
- Private airstrip.
- Accessible by air or road (self-drive options available).
- Swimming pool.
- Sleep Out Deck.
- Wheelchair accessible.

Open season and child policy

- All year round.

A little bit about Dinaka

The annual rains transform the arid desert landscape into a lush profusion of Kalahari vegetation, offering guests a unique insight into the lesser known desert experience.

Situated alongside the Central Kalahari Game Reserve, the focus of activities at Dinaka is exploring the Kalahari experience with wildlife ranging from giraffe to the antelope, small mammals like the honey badger, bat eared fox and porcupine to predators including the Kalahari lion, cheetah, leopard and brown hyena.

Activities include morning and afternoon game drives in open safari vehicles, with afternoon game drives often continuing into the evening. Our window seat guarantee ensures no more than four guests per vehicle when out on game drives. Alternatively, you may get more up close and personal with nature on foot with guided bush walks. Birding is particularly spectacular as Dinaka hosts over 200 different bird species including the Kori Bustard and Crimson Breasted Shrike and a high concentration of Pale Chanting Goshawks.





Dinaka Accommodation

Guests are accommodated in seven spacious twin and doublebedded safari tents, each en-suite bathroom has an indoor and outdoor shower, hot and cold running water and flush toilet.

Families are accommodated in a two-bedroomed tent, sharing a spacious en-suite bathroom – ideal for families in this child-friendly camp.

Dinaka's tents are well spaced and raised up on wooden decks giving the perfect vantage point over a permanent water hole. Connected by wooden walkways all areas of camp are accessible by wheelchair.









Dinaka Activities

Dinaka, meaning "horns", is a private reserve located on the northern boundary of the Central Kalahari Game Reserve.

The reserve offers an educational walk with San Bushmen in addition to day and night game drives.

Year-round water holes result in spectacular photographic opportunities either from the underground bunker, hide or vehicle.

The perfect contrast to a stay in the Okavango Delta, with an added hidden treasure!



- The Sleep Out Deck offers guests a panoramic view and the opportunity to spend the night under the magnificent African night sky
- Requires advanced booking .
- Available to guests staying three or more nights at Dinaka.
- Bathroom facilities consist of a toilet and wash basin.
- Your tent will be kept for you back at camp.
- Your guide, contactable by two way radio, will be accommodated a comfortable distance away.

Vehicle Policy – Window Seat Guarantee

- Toyota Land Cruisers customized into Game Viewers.
- Maximum 4 people per vehicle.
- Guaranteed window seat for all guests.
- Camera Mount for each window seat padded armrest that moves up and down.
- 2 rows 3 seats per row.
- Removable roof and folded down windscreen.
- Curtesy lights and easy access steps.
- Compartment for each row to store camera equipment, binoculars and personal items.
- Also on the vehicle bean bags, wet-wipes, hand sanitizer, tissues, toilet paper, paper bags and mints.
- Cooler box with refreshments and glass water bottles.
- Tea box for morning activities and sundowner snack for afternoon activities.
- Private vehicle available on request ahead of travel.
